



A.M. WORKSHOPS:

Morning workshops are instructed in separate, age appropriate groups determined by camper interest and ability.

“World Wonder Woodworking”: Intended for the tiniest hands of our program, campers will work with various wood materials to create beautiful masterpieces.

“Tiny Green Thumbs”: The youngest and most intrigued campers will discover their green thumbs on the beautiful campus of Trinity Montessori.

“Hip Hop Dance”: 3 & 4 year old participants will learn the art of hip-hop as they twist, pop and lock their way to a choreographed dance.

“Silly Sciences”: Explosions, slime and nature: oh my! Campers will learn the process of hypothesis and reactions as they perform hands on experiments.

“Mixed Media”: Tiny hands will have opportunity to put their creative thinking skills to the test as they create beautiful art work from various materials together.

“Petite Puppeteers”: Children use their imagination in creation their own character to bring to life—puppet style.

“Kids’ Carpentry”: Instructed by a renowned carpenter, campers will gain safe experience with woodworking tools to produce something useful to take home.

Afternoon workshops are **PLAYSHOPS!** Your child may choose only one to participate in throughout the week.

“Cooking Around the World”: Italian, French, Mexican and more! Campers chop, stir, boil and bake cuisine from around the world.

“Kids in Motion”: Children learn about various art forms through movement: human Spirograph, gravity painting, splat art and more!
